It was felt that this was perhaps not required given the present dormant state of the hall. Sarah agreed to assess the requirements and cover of the policy and take into account the Church's liability of the hall's insurance. The expense of purchasing PPE and cleaning materials etc. to cover safety requirements for the hall's use was felt to be prohibitive to re – opening the hall. Further information received from the Church official states that their insurance policy covers the hall and this would allow the HVHA to cancel their policy until required. It was also suggested that the insurance for the musical instrument (harp) the HVHA rent out be cancelled and the renter approached regarding a possible purchase. Despite the lack of recent activity it was felt that it was important to retain the HVHA as a community group but in the interest of safety and to preserve funds the committee unanimously agreed to "mothball" activities and review the situation at the AGM on 5 th October at 7pm.
